Apply by mop, sponge, brush, sprayer or automatic scrubber. This pine oil cleaner imparts a clean, fresh pine scent. To obtain maximum deodorization, allow the solution to remain in contact with surfaces for at least ten minutes before rinsing.

Directions

Wear safety equipment recommended on MSDS, read all directions and cautions prior to beginning your work.



Light Soil: Dilute 4 to 8 ounces per gallon of hot or warm water.

Heavy Soil: Dilute 8 to 12 ounces per gallon of hot or warm water.



For exceptionally tough deodorizing jobs, such as garbage cans, allow the solution to remain on the surface without rinsing.



For automatic floor scrubbing machines, use 4 to 8 ounces per gallon of hot or warm water.
